A scenic Trans Himalayan flight over the towering Himalayan peaks including Everest and Choholmari will bring you to Paro, the only International Airstrip of Bhutan. Bhutan Dragon takes you to the Bhutanese Capital Thimpu, Paro and Phunaka.

Bhutan Dragon Tour unfolds right after your arrival at Paro. During the cultural sightseeing tour of Paro we take you to Paro Ringpung Dzong, which is one of Bhutan's most remarkable dzongs, and possibly manifests the finest paradigm of Bhutanese architecture. The vegetable market at Paro adds the lively aura to the tour. The hiking escapade to the cliff-hanging Tiger's Nest (Taktsang Monastery), which nestles 90m above Paro Valley, is the prime highlight at Paro.

Now, the Dragon Tour in Bhutan heads towards Bhutanese Capital Thimpu. Trashi Choe Dzong Dechen Phodrang Changangkha Lhakhang, Changlimithang Stadium and Archery Ground, Zangto Pelri Lhakhang and several other monuments in Thimpu are significant landmarks you will be visiting for insightful tour of Thimpu. Then your trip continues towards Punakha. The major attraction of Phunaka is Chimli Lakhang Temple which is also well known as fertility temple. The temple jam-packed with baby monks stands high on the hilltop offering the magnificent views of the valleys. Phunaka is also popular for marvelous statues, paintings and the enlightening preaching of Buddha.

Exploring three major towns of the kingdom, which is also known as the land of Thunder Dragon is a cultural tour that unfolds the best of Bhutan's urbanity and semi-urban regions.
