**Altitude:** Muktinath is located at a high altitude, so it's important to acclimatize properly, especially if you're traveling from lower altitudes.

**Best time to visit:** The best time to visit Muktinath is during the spring (March to May) and autumn (September to November) when the weather is stable and the views of the mountains are clear.

**Transport:** The road from Jomsom to Muktinath can be rough, so it's best to travel in a jeep. However, there are also trekking routes if you're up for a more challenging adventure.

#### Trip Highlights

Visit the famous Lord Vishnu temple in the Himalayas. Scenic view of Dhaulagiri and Nilgiri Himalayas range The lost of Kingdom Mustang and Jomsom Kaligandaki River valley Saligram (fossil stone) Spotted place Drive experience via World deepest gorge along the Kali River. #### **Day 01: Day 01: Pick up from hotel fly to Pokhara - Drive to Jomsom**

Pick up from your hotel/home and transfer to Kathmandu domestic airport, fly to pokhara and drive to Jomsom by private jeep. The road is 170km long drive along the kali river bank passing many beautiful villages, water fall, world deepest gorge and mountain scenery. Stat at hotel in Jomsom.

#### **Day 02: Day 02: Drive to Muktinath Temple, Darshan and drive back to Pokahra.**

Early morning, one hour drive to near Muktianath Temple, walk about 30 minutes and Muktinath Temple darshan, puja, holy bath and get bless. Enjoy the sarrounding view of majestic Himalayas

and mountain atmosphere. Then drive back to Pokhara

### **Day 03: Day 03: Pokhara tour and fly back to Kathmandu. Transfer to Hotel.**

Visit the highlights of Pokhara city, drive to Davis water fall at the end of fewa lake, boating and visit the Barahi temple in the fewa lake island, Guptshwor Mahadev cave. After that, visit the most famous and scenic Pumdikot hill where the largest Lord Shiva statue with the panoramic view of Pokhara. Drive back to airport and fly to Kathmandu. Transfer to Hotel. To night your hotel is included.
