## **Muktinath Tour By Helicopter**

## **Trip Overview**

The Muktinath Helicopter Tour is a luxurious and time-efficient way to visit the sacred Muktinath Temple, one of the most revered pilgrimage sites in Nepal. Located in the Mustang district at an altitude of 3,710 meters (12,172 feet), Muktinath is a significant spiritual destination for both Hindus and Buddhists. The helicopter tour offers a breathtaking aerial journey through the Himalayas, allowing travelers to experience the beauty of the region while avoiding the long and challenging trek.

## **Muktinath Temple - the shrine of Salvation**

A holy site for Hindus, who believe that visiting Muktinath brings salvation (Moksha). A revered place for Buddhists, who know it as Chumig Gyatsa, a place of meditation and enlightenment. The temple complex features 108 water spouts and two holy kundas (ponds) where pilgrims take ritual baths.

#### Day 1: Day 01: Morning drive to airport and helicopter flight to Muktinath Temple - Return

Take a short drive from hotel to airport and security checking process, Get helicopter boarding pass and helicopter flight to Muktinath Temple. Landing near by Temple and take a short walk to visit the Muktinath Temple, Darshan and holy bath if you wish. Get bless from Temple and Guru, walk around with the scenic view of Mountain Dhaulagiri then walk down to Helicopter. Heli ride back to Pokhara either Kathmandu. Overall helicopter tour takes about 4 hours.
