Trip Overview

Achieving salvation at Muktinath...

Muktinath Temple is one of most popular religious Temple is symbol of both Hindus and Buddhists. Located at 3800 meter above the Kali River bank in the Himalayas where Saligram (Fossil Stones) easily finds as symbol of lord Vishnu. The Muktinath Temple tour is also one of most sacred pilgrimage destination in the Himalayas.

The temple yatra to Muktinath conduct from Kathmandu either Pokhara via Jomsom and Galeshwor Mahadev temple.

Take a puja and darshan of Shree Pashupatinath Temple the yatra goes further. Kathmandu is occupied with sacred shrines and medieval courtyards including the seven World Heritage sites sprinkled at different localities of Nepal. Despite of throughout ancient Kathmandu prides on keeping its antique legacy unharmed. The tour is all about journeying to the monuments where the past remains alive in the present.

The Pokhara City

Pokhara city is best part is the reflection of Mt. Fishtail on the crystal clear serene lake Fewa. A hilltop overlooking Pokhara, Sarangkot is just 30 minutes drive from any part of Pokhara. You can enjoy the vistas of widespread mountain ranges which look even more glorious during the sunrise and sunset. From Pokhara you will fly to the apple orchard of Nepal, Jomsom. Popularly known as windy valley, Jomsom is the gateway to forbidden Kingdom Mustang.

Jomsom is heart of Mustang on the bank of Kali river which is come from Damodar Kunda.

After short drive along the kali river, you will reach to Muktinath Temple. You can take a holy bath from 108 holy waterspouts and get molxhya by taking a bath from Muktikund, A holy walk around the temple and to see the holy flame, Swaminarayan and various temples your soul will be purified.

Best time to go Muktinath Temple

Muktinath Temple is one of the highest elevated Hindu temple in the Annapurna Himalayas. During the winter season, the temple is covered by heavy snow and the temperature is below 0 degree. After the winter from half of February until June months and September to November months is best time to visit the Temple. Although, there are many pilgrimage people, trekkers and adventure nature lovers take a tour all around the year.

Weather in Muktinath Temple

Muktinath Temple located in the high Himalayas behind the Annapurna Mountain just above the Kali River in Mustang. Generally the temperature of Mustang is cool, cold and windy and snowy season. If you are travelling to Muktinath in Spring season (September to November) 5 to 15 clcs and winter time always below 0 degree. If you are travelling Autumn Season the temperature quite warm and 7 to 20 clcs but during the night will be 0 to 7 clcs.

Day 1: Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu, Overnight at Kathmandu.

Arrival in Kathmandu Airport, warm welcome by our representative from Himalayan Glory Travels and Tours, transfer to Hotel. At evening, drive to Pashupatinath Arati, later short information about the tour. Overnight at Kathmandu.

Day 2: Day 2: Early Morning, Pashupatinath Darshan, Drive Kathmandu-Pokhara

Morning, pashpatinath darshan, puja and after breakfast drive to Pokhara via Manakamana Temple Darshan. Transfer to Hotel. Overnight at Pokhara.

Day 3: Day 3: Pokhara-Jomsom-Muktinath

Morning fly to Jomsom (Daily Scheduled Flight), Local jeep drive to Muktinath Temple along the Kaligandaki River bank. Arrival at Ranipauwa 3710 Mtr. Walks to Muktinath temple 3800 Mtr. /30 Minutes. Take a Holy bath from 108 soputs, Temple Darshan and puja - hawan. Darshan of Jwalamai Temple, Vishnupaduka and holy circle of Muktinath Temple, Take a lunch near by Temple and free time. Afternoon, return back to Jeep stand and drive back to Jomsom, overnight hotel. **Note:** There is Horse and Motorbike service from bus stop to the mukktinath Temple for alternative option to desiable yatries.

Day 4: Day 4: Jomsom Pokhara, Pokhara City Sightseeing

Morning flight to Pokhara, check- in hotel then Pokhara city sightseeing including Phewa Lake, Tal Barahi Temple, Bindabasini Temple, Davis Falls, Gupteshwor Cave, Drive to Sarangkot for amazing sunset view in Annapurna Himalayas Range. Back to Hotel. Overnight at Pokhara.

Day 5: Day 5: Pokhara-Kathmandu

Drive back to Kathmandu and transfer to the hotel. Free time at evening for shopping and exploring the local market. Overnight at Kathmandu.

Day 6: Day 6: Departure to onward destination.

As this is final day of entire Muktinath YatraTour, you will have some free time at morning for packing and shopping)
